



Sick Policy

According to the State of Virginia Department of Licensing, a child must go home with any of the following symptoms:

- A fever of 101.00 or more
- Diarrhea (You will be notified after the first time, required to pick up after the second)
- Vomiting
- An unidentifiable rash that bothers the child
- Discharge and/or irritation to the eye(s) and/or ear(s)
- Any other symptoms that management feels should be inspected by a physician

Following the onset of any of the above listed symptoms, you will be notified via phone call, text and email and given 30 minutes to respond and 1 hour to make arrangements for the child to be picked up. If we cannot contact you within 30 minutes, we will call emergency contacts on file and if that fails, we will be forced to contact the necessary authorities to arrange for treatment of the child.

Your child may return after 1 of the 3 happens:

1. You provide management with a doctor's note confirming that the child is not contagious AND allowing the child to return to school.
2. The child is 24 hours symptom free without the use of medication.
3. After the child has been treated by a doctor and has received antibiotics, he/she can return after the first 24 hours following the first dose of medicine.

In addition, the parent must notify the center if any member of the family has a reportable, communicable disease confirmed within 24 hours of the next business day. All life threatening diseases must be reported to the center immediately.
